What is the Thomas Jefferson Scholarship Program?

- Provides opportunities for outstanding undergraduate university/institute students from Tunisia for an academic year of non-degree study at accredited four-year colleges and universities in the United States
- Participants gain a deeper understanding of the United States as well as new skills and knowledge to help them contribute to Tunisia's economic growth and development
- Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State with funding provided by the United States Government and supported in its implementation by IREX

What is included in the Scholarship?

The Thomas Jefferson Scholarship Program provides:

- J-1 visa support;
- Round-trip travel from student's home city to host institution in the United States;
- Tuition and mandatory university fees;
- Room and board (housing and meals);
- Small incidentals allowance;
- Limited allowance for books;
- Accident and sickness coverage;
- A wide variety of alumni networking and training opportunities

Thomas Jefferson Scholarship Program

- Attend U.S. universities and 4-year colleges
- University coursework includes courses in field of study and American studies
- 1-3 Thomas Jefferson Scholars per host institution
- Open to a broad variety of technical and non-technical fields of study

What does the application include?

- General background information & visa history
- Academic history
- Past extracurricular/work experience
- Short answers
- Essays
- 2 Reference Forms

Tips for short answers and essays

- Use concrete examples
- Don't be afraid to start over
- Don't copy another person's ideas or work without giving credit! (you will be disqualified)
- Be yourself - don't try too hard to impress the reader
- Revise it at least three times

 - **If you miss this step, your application will not be submitted!**

Selection process

- Merit-based, open competition
- The Thomas Jefferson Scholarship Program does not discriminate against applicants on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, or any other protected characteristic as established by U.S. law.
- All applications are first reviewed for technical eligibility
- Eligible applications are read, evaluated & ranked by panel of higher education specialists
- Highest rankings = Semi-finalists
- Semi-finalists are interviewed and take the TOEFL test
